NEW Client Consent Standard & Clinical Practice Guideline

Obtaining informed client consent, and documenting that consent, is a key component of good practice. The standard for client consent has been removed from the Standard of Practice on [Documentation and Record Management \(SOP-PRAC-01\)](#) and is now a separate standard that is required by all registrants: [Client Consent \(SOP-PRAC-06\)](#).

The CSHHPBC Board has also adopted the Ministry of Health [Care Providers' Guide to Consent to Health Care \(ACPG-12\)](#).
